

NASCAR ARCA MENARDS SERIES WEST FACT SHEET

What: The ARCA Menards Series West returned to Sonoma as part of the Toyota/Save Mart 350 weekend for the General Tire 200 on Saturday, June 11.

When: June 11th. This is the fifth stop on the 11-race West Series schedule.

Circuit: 10-turn, 1.99-mile road course

Length: 56 laps *(Race was shortened to 56 laps due to time constraints.)



2022 Series Champion: Jake Drew (No. 6 Irwindale Speedway/Lucas Oil/Stilo USA/Molecule Ford)

Race Notes:

Jake Drew raced to the ARCA Menards West Series victory Saturday, claiming the General Tire 200 at Sonoma Raceway. Drew, from Fullerton, Calif., was declared the winner due to time constraints with eight laps to go in the 64-lap event around the challenging 10-turn, 1.99-mile road course. It was Drew's second consecutive victory of the season. The race had several cautions, including a seven-car pileup at Turn 11 on lap 56 which ultimately forced ARCA officials to end the race on time under caution. Drew, who started on the pole at the controls of his No. 6 Irwindale Speedway/Lucas Oil Ford, battled with North Carolina racer Landen Lewis in the No. 17 Premier Security Chevrolet and Cole Moore, from Orangevale, Calif., in the No. 99 Adaptive One Chevy for the lead early in the race. Lewis and Moore were eventually collected in a crash after making contact with the No. 91 Toyota of Colby Howard and Drew was able to pull away and remain in the lead. Howard, Dale Quarterly, Jack Wood and Joey Iest completed the top five in the race. Moore finished 12th and Lewis finished 14th.

About the West Series:

The ARCA Menards Series West began in 1954 as the Pacific Coast Late Model circuit and is the West Coast's oldest stock car racing circuit. Nine races were held in the first year, many of which were held in California, in cities such as Oakland, San Diego, San Mateo and Gardena. The inaugural series championship was won by Lloyd Dane driving a 1953 Hudson Hornet. The series competes throughout the Western region of the United States, and has been a launching pad for the careers of **Ron Hornaday Jr.**, **Kevin Harvick**, **Kurt Busch**, **David Gilliland** and many other drivers.

Notable:

Jake Drew became the 200th winner in the history of the [ARCA Menards Series West](#) when he took the checkered flag in a shortened race at Portland International Raceway and Saturday's [General Tire 200 at Sonoma Raceway](#) did not end with winner No. 201 in West Series history, because Drew repeated his feat from a week before. The 22-year-old from Fullerton, California, won another shortened event to mark his second career victory.

NASCAR WEST SERIES PIT NOTES

- Noah Gragson collected his fifth NASCAR ARCA Menard's Series West race win and seventh victory in the ARCA Menard's Series in 2019.
- In 2018, Will Rodgers led a race-high 35 laps, was fastest in practice and secured the pole position for the second consecutive year before claiming the checkered flag.
- California native Kevin Harvick became the first-ever driver to win both the Toyota/Save Mart 350 Monster Energy NASCAR Cup Series race and the NASCAR Pro Series West race in the same weekend. In 2017, Harvick also won the West Series event at then-Infineon Raceway in 1998, en route to the West Series championship.
- David Gilliland's 2012 victory marked the sixth Sonoma win for the Gilliland family. David's father, Butch, claimed wins on the road course in 1991 (twice), 1994 and 1996. David's first Sonoma victory came in 2007.
- In 2009, four-time Sonoma West Series winner, Hershel McGriff, became the oldest driver in modern history (81) to attempt to qualify for a NASCAR-sanctioned event.
- Eight of the last 15 West Series races in Sonoma have been won by NASCAR Cup regulars – Kevin Harvick, 1998 & 2017; Brian Vickers, 2006; Joey Logano, 2011; David Gilliland, 2007 & 2012; Kyle Larson, 2014, Chase Elliott, 2016 and Chase Briscoe, 2021.
- The West Series has held 40 events in Sonoma dating back to 1978, including annual visits from 1978-1989.
- Winningest drivers in the West Series at Sonoma Raceway are Butch Gilliland (1994, '96, '97 (twice)); Hershel McGriff (1983, '85, '87, '89); and Bill Schmitt (1981, '88, '89, '91).
- Hershel McGriff has captured the most West Series poles in Sonoma with three.
- Notable drivers who have competed in West Series events in Sonoma over the years: Chase Briscoe, Chase Elliot, Bobby Allison, David Pearson, Neil Bonnett, Buddy Baker, Tommy Kendall, Bob Bondurant, Joey Logano and Kevin Harvick.
