

TOYOTA/SAVE MART 350 FACT SHEET

What: The NASCAR Cup Series visits the Sonoma Valley for the 35th time at the Toyota/Save Mart 350.

When: June 7-9, 2024

Circuit: 10-turn, 1.99-mile road course.

Race Length:

The Toyota/Save Mart 350 will span 110 laps. The race distance is 218.9 miles or 110 laps around the 1.99-mile road course. The Toyota/Save Mart 350 is measured in kilometers. The race stages will be 25 laps, 55 laps and 110 laps.

New Rule Package:

This weekend marks the road-course debut of NASCAR's reduced-downforce package designed to enhance competition on road courses and the circuit's shorter oval tracks. The changes include significantly smaller spoilers, splitters and other aerodynamic devices in an effort to place a greater emphasis on handling and driver input with less stabilizing downforce on those tracks. The package draws inspiration from similar rules used in the 2017-18 seasons.

2023 Champion: Martin Truex Jr.

Race Notes:

Martin Truex Jr. chose the correct road course pit stop strategy, and it proved to make all the difference as he and the No. 19 Joe Gibbs Racing Toyota team dominated the 34th annual NASCAR Cup Series Toyota/Save Mart 350 at Sonoma Raceway.

The Mayetta, N.J., native led four times for 51 laps, including the final 14, to take the checkered flag 2.979 seconds ahead of Kyle Busch in the No. 8 Richard Childress Racing Chevrolet.

The balance of the top 10 finishers were Joey Logano, Ricky Stenhouse Jr., Chase Elliott, AJ Allmendinger, Michael McDowell, Kyle Larson, Christopher Bell and Ross Chastain.

The Toyota/Save Mart 350 victory was Truex's second of the season and fourth career win at Sonoma Raceway (2013, 2018, 2019 and 2023), just one behind Jeff Gordon for all-time wins at the speedway. It was his 33rd win in 637 NASCAR Cup Series starts.

"I felt like our Bass Pro Shops Camry TRD was really close yesterday in practice, if we could make a few adjustments, I thought we would be good," said Truex. "They definitely made the right adjustments.

"This place is all about rear traction, rear drive and being able to manage that and keep turning and keep momentum. We were able to do that today. The car was really, really good. Just a total team effort. Everybody works really, really hard.

"We were awful here last year, and at road course in general, so to come back here – this has kind of been a playground for us before, and to be able to get back here with this car and do it again feels really, really special. It's really gratifying. We've worked hard for this one."

Hamlin, who won the pole with a qualifying lap of 77.719 seconds at 92.178 mph, led the field to green and established the No. 11 Joe Gibbs Racing Toyota at the front of the field with each successive lap. He was 0.73-of-a-second ahead of JGR teammate Bell after the second lap and built a two-second lead on Bell after 10 laps, with Truex, Tyler Reddick fourth and Ty Gibbs rounding out the top 5.



The leaders stayed out very late into the second stage and only came to pit road on Lap 51 after the day's first caution was waved due a loose tire from Zane Smith's car on pit road. The Top 10 running order when the caution waved was Truex, Hamlin, Bell, McDowell, Elliott, Allmendinger, Buescher, Larson, Reddick and Gibbs.

Truex won the race off pit road, followed by Bell and McDowell, but it was Kyle Busch, who came to pit road prior to the yellow, who led the flag back to green on Lap 54. Truex lined up 10th with Logano, Byron, Chastain, Austin Dillon, Stenhouse, Keselowski, Harvick and Suarez lined up ahead of him, filling the space in between him and Busch.

Busch won Stage 2 after Lap 55 with the balance of the Top 10 consisting of Logano, Chastain, Byron, Stenhouse, Dillon, Truex, McDowell, Harvick and Bell.

Busch maintained the lead over the next 13 circuits as Truex moved to fourth by Lap 61, third the next lap and second on Lap 64. Truex moved past Busch in Turn 7 on Lap 69 and kept the top spot until coming to pit lane on Lap 75 along with Busch and Allmendinger.

Truex reclaimed the top spot five laps later and held it until Hamlin hit the wall in Turn 12 on Lap 92, ping-ponged between the two frontstretch barriers and broke the right rear toe link on his Toyota.

Chase Elliott, Tyler Reddick and Ryan Blaney stayed out on older tires during the ensuing caution, but Truex made short work of those drivers, retaking the lead off Turn 4 on Lap 97, with Busch following him into the second spot.

Busch chased Truex over the final 14 laps—to no avail.

"I wish we had a little bit more," said Busch, who won last Sunday at World Wide Technology Raceway. "I tried really hard at the end to at least try to keep Martin honest. Felt like I could beat him a little bit on a lap, then I would mess up. He would beat me by a little bit more on the next lap. We were just kind of trading a little bit there. He was able to pull away there late.

"There were 10 lead changes among six drivers (Hamlin, Truex, Busch, McDowell, Elliot and Chastain) and two cautions for six laps.

The unofficial 2023 NASCAR Cup Series point standings after 16 races is Martin Truex Jr. (525, William Byron (-13), Ryan Blaney (-24), Ross Chastain (-24), Kevin Harvick (-25), Kyle Busch (-29), Christopher Bell (-32), Denny Hamlin (-63), Joey Logano (-81) and Kyle Larson (-85).

HISTORY OF NASCAR CUP RACING IN SONOMA

Through 34 NASCAR Cup races in Sonoma, there have been 20 different race winners as 64 drivers have led the field over 3,411 laps. Here are a few highlights:

1989: Ricky Rudd wins the inaugural Winston Cup race at then-Sears Point Raceway, beating Rusty Wallace by just 1.1 seconds. Bill Elliott was third and Dale Earnhardt fourth.

1991: Ricky Rudd crosses the finish line first, but Davey Allison is declared the winner after Rudd was assessed a penalty 2 ½ hours after the race. Rudd bumped Allison on lap 73 of the 74-lap race and was shown the black flag. Allison got the checkers.

1992: Ernie Ivan claims his first Sonoma victory in the Save Mart Supermarkets 300. Ivan was black-flagged at the start after crossing the starting line ahead of pole winner Ricky Rudd, but came back to pass 41 cars to take the checkered flag.

1994: Ernie Ivan becomes the first two-time winner of a NASCAR Cup event in Sonoma.

1995: Dale Earnhardt wins his only NASCAR road-course race.

1997: After finishing second in 1990, 1995 and 1996, Mark Martin wins his first NASCAR Cup race in Sonoma and becomes the second driver to start on the pole and win the race.

2000: Jeff Gordon makes it three in a row in Sonoma.

2006: Jeff Gordon captures his fifth NASCAR Cup win in Sonoma, a track record.

2007: Juan Pablo Montoya becomes the first rookie to win a NASCAR event in Sonoma and the third foreign-born driver to win a NASCAR Cup race.

2008: Kyle Busch earns his first NASCAR Cup Series road-course victory and Toyota's first victory on the Sonoma Valley road course.

2009: Kasey Kahne takes the checkers, earning his first NASCAR Cup Series road-course victory and the first victory since 1999 for team owner Richard Petty.

2015: Kyle Busch claims his second Sonoma victory on the way to his first Cup Series championship. It was Busch's first victory of the year after missing 11 races due to injuries sustained in an XFINITY Series crash in Daytona.

2016: Tony Stewart claims the last victory of his historic Cup Series career with a last-lap pass of Denny Hamlin. It marked his third Sonoma Raceway win and ended an 84-race winless streak.

2017: Kevin Harvick becomes the first driver in Sonoma history to sweep both the Saturday and Sunday main event, and earns his first NASCAR Cup Series Sonoma victory.

2019: Martin Truex Jr. becomes the first driver since 2000 (Jeff Gordon) to post back-to-back Sonoma victories. This also marked the return to full, 12-turn road course.

2021: Elk Grove, CA native Kyle Larson gets his first-career victory at his home track of Sonoma Raceway, where he grew up watching races as a child.

2022: Daniel Suarez earned an emotional first-career NASCAR Cup Series victory by leading the final 26 laps. He became the first Mexican-born driver in NASCAR history to earn a victory.

2023: Martin Truex Jr. earns his 4th career victory at Sonoma Raceway, one shy of the record held by Jeff Gordon (5).

TOYOTA/SAVE MART 350 PIT NOTES

- The 2018 Toyota/Save Mart 350 set a new track record for greatest margin of victory. Martin Truex Jr. beat Kevin Harvick by 10.513 seconds. This dethroned Ernie Irvan's long-standing record of 9.56 seconds over Geoffrey Bodine, set in 1994.
- Clint Bowyer is the active driver with the most top-five finishes in Sonoma (8).
- Kyle Larson has posted five consecutive pole positions in Sonoma.
- Dale Earnhardt won his only NASCAR road-course race in Sonoma in 1995.
- Brothers Kyle Busch and Kurt Busch finished 1-2, respectively, at Sonoma Raceway in 2015; it marked the first time the brothers ever finished 1-2 in Cup Series competition.
- Juan Pablo Montoya holds the track record for the greatest winning improvement; he started 32nd and went on to win in 2007. He was also the first rookie ever to win a NASCAR Cup event in Sonoma.
- The closest margin of victory occurred in 1999 when Jeff Gordon held off Mark Martin by .197 seconds.
- Jeff Gordon holds the record for the most poles with five ('98, '99, '01, '04, '05).
- Ernie Irvan (1994), Mark Martin (1997) and Jeff Gordon (1998, '99 and 2004) are the only drivers to win a race starting from the pole.
- Kyle Busch's 2008 victory marked Toyota's first-ever win in Sonoma. Brian Vickers earned Toyota its first pole in Sonoma in 2009 (93.678 mph). Toyota has posted six total Sonoma victories (Busch, '08 and '15; Bowyer, '12; Truex Jr., '13, '18, '19).
- Chevrolet has powered 11 of the 22 NASCAR winners: Ernie Irvan ('92), Dale Earnhardt ('95), Jeff Gordon ('98, '99, '00, '04, '06), Robby Gordon ('03), Tony Stewart ('05, '16) and Jimmie Johnson ('10). Ford has eight wins: Davey Allison ('91), Geoffrey Bodine ('93), Ernie Irvan ('94), Rusty Wallace ('96), Mark Martin ('97), Ricky Rudd ('02), Carl Edwards ('14) and Kevin Harvick ('17).
- Dodge has three victories in Sonoma with Juan Pablo Montoya (2007), Kasey Kahne (2009) and Kurt Busch (2011). Pontiac scored two victories with Rusty Wallace (1990) and Tony Stewart (2001) behind the wheel, while Ricky Rudd drove a Buick to victory at the inaugural NASCAR race in 1989.

- Sixteen car owners have claimed victories in Sonoma: King Racing ('89), Blue Max ('90), Morgan-McClure ('92), Bud Moore ('93), Richard Childress ('95, '03), Roger Penske ('96, '11), Roush Racing ('97, '14), Rick Hendrick ('98-'00, '04, '06, '10 '21), Joe Gibbs ('01, '05, '08, '15, '19), Robert Yates ('91, '94, '02), Chip Ganassi with Felix Sabates ('07), Richard Petty Motorsports ('09), Michael Waltrip Racing ('12, '13), Stewart-Haas Racing ('16, '17) and Furniture Row Racing ('18) Trackhouse ('22).
- Tony Stewart (2016) and Kevin Harvick (2017) posted back-to-back Sonoma wins for Stewart-Haas Racing, becoming the first team to score consecutive Sonoma wins since Michael Waltrip Racing did it with Clint Bowyer (2012) and Martin Truex, Jr. (2013).
- Terry Labonte and Michael Waltrip share the track record for the biggest improvement from qualifying to finish at 36 positions. In 2002, Labonte started 39th and finished third. Waltrip started 40th and finished fourth in 2004.
- Jeff Gordon holds the record for the most races led at 12. Gordon has led 22 times for a total of 440 laps, the most of any driver. He also holds the record for most laps completed at 2,343.
